The other keynote presentation will be delivered by Vaclav Pech from JetBrains who will be presenting on IntelliJ IDEA 7.0 and JBoss Development. JetBrains IntelliJ is an award-winning Java Integrated Development Environment (IDE), recognised by many as the best and the most innovative Java IDE for its unprecedented refactoring support, intelligence and usability. Version 7.0 is the latest version of IntelliJ IDEA.

The JBug is a regular gathering of JBoss Professional and other Open Source product users, and provides a forum that enables users and customers to get together and discuss new technologies, development methodologies, interesting use cases and similar technical topics. At each meeting, different speakers will present on topics that can be suggested by the group.
